The answers to the clues below reveal key letters needed to solve your *Unlock It!* adventure.

On the grass trail, find the memorial to the family that helped make this park possible. Name the one who had the longest life?

While enjoying the vistas from this highest point in the park, take note of the tallest structure in Minnesota, the KPX TV tower which stands 1505 feet above the earth. How many flashing lights do you see on it from here (spell that number)?

As you walk through the portion of trail where the canopy of trees forms a tunnel, how many of the white oaks can you find that have a rare Y-split trunk (spell the number)?

At first glance, the picnic tables appear to be made only out of wood. But, what material keeps them from collapsing? *Hint: Desired answer is one syllable.*

You will find several big rocks around all 3 picnic areas in the south half of the park. How many total rocks are found at the two picnic areas with the most rocks?
